

# WICKEDLY PERFECT PARTY GAMES

So you've decorated your house, you've donned the ultimate costume, and you've set out a spook-tacular array of snacks – what's left for your ghostly guests? Why the party games of course! Here are a few to perk things up!



## Ghosts in the Graveyard!

Step 1: Gather your friends at dusk.

Step 2: Designate a home base tree.

Step 3: Play rock, paper, scissors to decide who's the ghost.

Step 4: Everyone stands at home base while the ghost runs off to hide.

Step 5: As a group count, "One o'clock... two o'clock... three o'clock in the graveyard...four o'clock...five o'clock...six o'clock in the graveyard" and so on, up to twelve o'clock. Then shout, "Midnight! I hope I don't see the ghost tonight!"

Step 6: All brave souls begin looking for the ghost. The ghost's job is to jump out, scare the cookies out of the seekers, and tag someone. Anyone who sees the ghost shouts, "Ghost in the graveyard!" and tries to get back to home base. Anyone who is caught becomes a ghost too.

Step 7: All the people who were caught and now are ghosts, go and hide with the original ghost. Everyone else stays at home base and starts again counting...one o'clock...two o'clock...

Step 8: Continue scaring the cookies out of each other until everyone is caught or it gets too dark. The last person caught becomes the ghost for the next game.
